Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

Under CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) and Continuous Assessment & Grading Pattern (CAGP)

This course will of 26 nos. Courses containing six semesters. In these sixth semesters, the course will be divided as – First- 4nos, Second- 4nos, third- 5nos, fourth 5nos, Fifth 4nos and sixth 4nos. Each course from first to sixth semester will carry 80 marks for theory and 20 marks for internal assessment. Internal assessment includes two sessional tests of 5 marks each, one home assignment of 5 marks and one group discussion or seminar presentation of 5 marks.

B.A. (General Course) in Bodo

Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

Under CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) and Continuous Assessment & Grading Pattern (CAGP)

This course will consist of 22 nos. courses containing six semesters. In these six semesters, the course will be divided as – First-3nos, Second-3nos, third-4nos, fourth-4nos, Fifth-4nos and sixth-4nos. Each course from first to sixth semester will carry 80 marks for theory and 20 marks for internal assessment. Internal assessment includes two sessional tests of 5 marks each, one home assignment of 5 marks and one group discussion or seminar presentation of 5 marks.
