
**Procedure for Admission and Other Information:**

3. The concerned Teaching Department/ Centre for Studies shall notify the List of the Selected Candidates (with Waiting List) in the Departmental/ Centre Notice Board by 11.02.2020.
4. The Selected Students shall have to confirm their enrolment (or take admission) at the relevant Teaching Department/ Centres for Studies within 12.02.2020. The concerned Teaching

Department/ Centres for Studies may notify their own schedule of enrolment (specific date and time) and commencement of classes, etc. along with the List of Selected Candidates.


5. The Teaching Department/ Centres for Studies may accept or reject the application of a candidate according to their preferences of subjects/ disciplines.
6. The Classes of the GE Courses shall be held from Monday to Thursday every week during 4.00 p.m. to 5.00/ 5.30 pm.
