

SPECIAL RULES FOR RESEARCH SCHOLAR'S HOSTEL, 2022

(Framed in compliance with the Clause 18 of the Dibrugarh University Hostel Rules, 2015 (Amended upto 28.10.2021) and subsequent approval in the 350 Meeting of the E.C. held on 31.08.2022)

1. TITLE

These rules shall be called "SPECIAL RULES FOR RESEARCH SCHOLAR'S HOSTEL, 2022".

2. COMPLIANCE

This Rule is framed in compliance with the Clause 18 of the Dibrugarh University Hostel Rules, 2015 (amended as per Resolution No.46 of the 347th Meeting of the Executive Council held on 28.10.2021). This Rule is an addition to the 'Dibrugarh University Hostel Rules, 2015 (amended upto date)' and thus, all other relevant clauses and provisions mentioned in the parent Rule shall be applicable to all Research Scholars admitted to Hostels.

3. ADMISSION

The following procedures shall be followed for admission of the research scholars.

Eligibility:

- (a) As the Academic Council (vide resolution no. DU/DR-A/43-1/124 AC/22/200 dated 03.03.2022) resolved to consider the date of Ph.D admission as Provisional date of registration, therefore, a candidate upon admission to the Research Programme shall be eligible for admission in Hostels.
- (b) A candidate must be a bona-fide full time researcher of the University in order to get admission in the Hostel. Further, he/she must not be engaged in any other organization/institution for monetary benefits (except fellowships/ scholarships) during the tenure of his Research Programme. If a boarder accepts job offers/assignments (part time or full time) in Government or Private Institutions/Agencies during the stay in the hostel, he/she shall have to vacate his/her seat in the Hostel immediately.

An Undertaking to that effect shall be obtained by the Wardens of the Hostels facilitating Research Scholars.

Criteria of Selection:

- (a) Admission of a Research Scholar for a particular Academic year from a particular Centre/ Department shall depend on the number of scholars enrolled in the in the

Research Programme of the Department/Center selected through DURAT and DURAT exempted candidates.

In order to accommodate the pending applications received prior to implementation of these Rules, preferences may be given to the Registered Research Scholars of the University.

- (b) The Departments/Centres shall prepare a list on the basis of merit (as per Statutory Reservation Policy followed by the University) considering both DURAT and DURAT exempted candidates and shall forward the same to the Chief Warden. The Chief Warden on the basis of vacancy in the respective Hostels shall allocate seats to the Departments and Centres proportionate to the number of enrollments in the research programmes in consultation with the Wardens of the Research Scholar's Hostel and the Dean, Students' Affairs, Dibrugarh University.
- (c) The list of selected candidates for admission into the Hostels shall be notified by the Chief Warden, Dibrugarh University Hostels.

Renewal:

- (d) The scholar must renew her/his stay in the hostel every year till the completion of the Research Work.

4. GUEST BOARDER (In connection with the Research Scholar):

Guest Boarder (in connection with Research Scholars) means:

- (a) A Research scholar of this university who pursue his/her research in other recognized Institutions or affiliated colleges. Such Research Scholars can avail the benefit of the hostel for a period of one month at a stretch subject to availability of seats. However, after the expiry of the tenure, the Research scholar may renew his/her period of stay with due approval from the Chief Warden.
- (b) A Research Scholar who is a bona-fide Research Scholar of the University but are not availing hostel seats. During the period of the Course Work Examinations or Submission of thesis, or in such other urgent works, such Scholars may be allowed to stay for the duration of the Examination or the Period of the submission of the thesis not exceeding one Month subject to availability of seats. However after the expiry of the tenure, the Research scholar may renew his/her period of stay with due approval from the Chief Warden.

Guest Boarders shall join the mess and shall pay mess fees as per the provision of the individual hostel mess guidelines.

On recommendation of the Dean, R&D, scholars of other Universities may also be facilitated a seat in the Hostel not exceeding 15 (Fifteen) Days. However, such stay may also be extended for a reasonable period on recommendation of the Dean, R&D
All other Rules concerning the Guest Boarders shall be same as mentioned in the parent Rules.

5. GENERAL RULES

- (a) As per the provisions of the Dibrugarh University Hostel Rules, 2015 (amended upto date).
- (b) Any other Rules/Guidelines/SoPs issued by the competent authority of the University from time to time.

6. SETTLEMENTS OF ISSUES

In case of any difficulty arises in allocation of seats to the research scholars and managing the affairs of the hostels, the Wardens Council may take up such matters and take appropriate steps in resolving them.
