HANDS ON TRAINING WORKSHOP ON OIL AND GAS TRAP IDENTIFICATION, WELL LOG INTERPRETATION AND WELL LOG CORRELATION ON 22^{ND} AND 23^{RD} MAY 2023

Department of Applied Geology, Dibrugarh University organized a hands-on training workshop on oil and gas Subsurface Trap Identification, Well Log Interpretation and Well Log Correlation on 22nd and 23rd May 2023 in collaboration with Oil India Limited, Duliajan amongst the students of M.Sc.
