



Dibrugarh University Regulations for the Certificate Course in TAI Language Spoken Course

As approved by the Board of Studies in Assamese (TAI)..... 2010.

1. Short title definitions and commencement

- I. These Regulations shall be called Dibrugarh University Regulations for the Certificate Course in Tai Language Spoken Course.

II. Definitions:

- (a) Department/ Centre: The term Department/ Centre is used to mean a Department/ Centre of Dibrugarh University or that of a Centre of the University established under section 2(7) of the Dibrugarh University Act. or that of a college affiliated to the Dibrugarh University with reference to the subject of study and designated as such by the University.

- (b) Certificate Course: It is a full time course for three months.

2. Extent of Application: These Regulations shall be applicable to the students enrolled for the Certificate Course in Tai Language Spoken Course, Dibrugarh University.

3. The Certificate Course in Tai Language Spoken Course shall be of three months duration.

4. Course Structure:

- (a) The questions shall be set from each paper/unit and students shall be required to answer questions in each paper/unit.

- (b) The minimum total marks in the Certificate Course shall be 100 marks. There will be one paper carrying 100 marks. The paper shall contain two parts: part-I written 60 marks and part-II viva 40 marks.

5. Admission: Newspaper Notice inviting application for admission into the course shall be issued by the Registrar or by any other person authorized for the purpose at least (five week in advance of the date of admission. Each applicant shall have to submit within the prescribed date his/ her application with requisite documents as indicated.

6. Eligibility to apply for admission 10+2 Passed candidates with 40% marks will be eligible for admission.

7. Attendance: A student shall have to attend 75% of the total classes held to be eligible to appear in Examination of Tai Language Spoken Course.

8. Examination and Evaluation:

- (a) Examinations will be conducted by the University after the completion of the Course in three months.
 - (b) To be eligible to appear in the Tai Language Spoken Certificate Course Examination as a regular candidate, a student must attend 75% of the lectures delivered during the academic session. A student attend at least 60% of the lectures delivered shall, however, be allowed to appear in the examination as a non-collegiate candidate on payment of a prescribed fee.
 - (c) A candidate shall be allowed a maximum of 1 more chances to complete the Tai Language Spoken Course.
 - (d) A student failing in the exam shall be allowed to clear these course in the next examination.
 - (e) Successful candidates shall be awarded a certificate by the University.
 - (f) The pass mark for the examination shall be as follows:
 - 1. Simple pass : 35% marks and above.
 - 2. Second Division: 45% Marks and above
 - 3. 1st Division: 60 % marks and above
 - (g) Examination of the course shall be conducted as per the Dibrugarh University Examination ordinance, 1972 (As amended).
9. Students who are unable to complete the course will be granted permission to readmit him/her in the next course.
10. For any matter not covered under these Regulations, the existing University Rules. Ordinance and Dibrugarh University Act. 1965 (as amended) shall be applicable.
11. Any difficulty which may arise in the course of the operations relating to holding of examinations for this course shall be removed by the Examination Committee of the University.

**THE PROGRAMME OF CURRICULUM FOR THREE MONTHS SELF
FINANCE TAI LANGUAGE SPOKEN COURSE**

The students are expected to know about the general idea of the Tai Language with details of alphabets with elementary grammar and sentence patterns, written practice, word collection, tone and simple conversation.

The course shall be of 3 (three) months duration.

After completion there shall be a written examination of 60 marks and 40 marks for viva. The successful candidate will be provided a certificate by the university.

The pass marks for examination shall be as follows:

The course programme and routine for the Spoken Tai Language Course will be as follows:

1. 1st week - Introduction to Tai Language – General Idea, Tai alphabet, sign of vowel
- 2nd week - Tai vocabulary acquisition with tones at least 30 words daily 30 x 6 =180 with feedback on every subsequent days
- 3rd week - Construction of Sentence
- 4th week - Conversation (person to person and in group)
- 5th week - Negative, Interrogative – practice of speaking
- 6th week - Tense, Degree of comparison – feedback and practice
- 7th week - Noun, adjective and pronoun - feedback and practice
- 8th week - Number, Gender, Classifier - feedback and practice
- 9th Week - Practice of speaking and writing
- 10th week - Tone practice of pronunciation
- 11th and 12th week } - Practice of speaking from Assamese to Tai and from Tai to Assamese and Examination on the last day.
