ADMISSION NOTICE for Master of Social Work (MSW) Programme Session 2023-2024

Online applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission into the Master of Social Work (MSW) Programme for the Academic Session 2023-2024. The Programme consists of 4 (four) semesters with a total duration of 2 (two) academic years.

Eligibility for Admission:

- (a) A Bachelor's degree under the 10+2+3 or 10+2+4 pattern from a recognized University securing a minimum of 45% marks in Major or in aggregate (40% for candidates from the Schedule Tribes, Schedule Castes and Other Backward Classes).
- (b) Candidates whose results for the qualifying examination are not yet declared may also apply.
- (c) Preference may be given to candidates from the North-Eastern States.

Application Procedure for the MSW Programme:

- 1. Application for Master of Social Work (MSW) Programme shall be through online mode only. No other means of application shall be accepted.
- 2. Online Registration for submission of Application Form will begin from 06.06.2023. The last date for submission of application is 25.06.2023 (till 11.55 p.m.)
- 3. For submission of the *Online Application Form*, intending candidates are advised to follow the following instructions:
 - a) For Online Application, please login to Admission Portal on https://dibru.ac.in or https://erp.dibru.work/
 - b) The Candidate needs to register on the portal by clicking the "Register" button and providing his/her name, mobile number and a password. The mobile number will be verified through an OTP. Please remember the password for login.
 - c) After successful registration, the candidate needs to login using his/her mobile number and the password.
 - d) After login, the candidate needs to click on the "Apply" button corresponding to the link of "MSW Programme" which will lead to an application form. The candidate needs to fill up the application form step by step.
 - e) After completion of the filling-up the Form Candidate needs to click the button "Submit and Review". A preview of the filled-up form will be displayed. Candidates are advised to carefully cross-check the information and if anything needs to be corrected at this stage, they can go back and edit

- f) After ensuring that all the information displayed on the Preview is correct, the candidate needs to click 'Pay now & Submit the application" and the pay the application fee of Rs 750/- only through online mode (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking).
- g) The application form will be considered finally submitted only when the application fee is successfully paid by the candidate and an online receipt is generated confirming the payment.
- h) There will be a button to download your Application Form and Admit Card for future reference.
- i) The Candidate shall have to take a print out of the Admit Card and bring the same to the Examination Hall on the Date of the Test for verification.
- j) The Submission of Online Application Forms shall be automatically closed after the last date.
- 4. There shall be no alternative procedure for Application for applying to the MSW Programme and the University shall not receive the Application except the procedure mentioned at (2) above.
- 5. Candidates seeking admission under the Non-Statutory Reservation Quota in the category of Sons and Daughters of the DU Employees/ Retired Employees shall have to submit a print out of the Submitted Online Application Form of the MSW Programme 2023 along with the self-attested copies of all relevant testimonials and a Filled in Prescribed Form on or before 25.06.2023 at the Centre for Social Work Studies, Dibrugarh University [Please refer Clause No. 2 (IV) (a) of 'Reservation and Relaxation Policy for admission into Post Graduate, Under Graduate, Advanced Post Graduate Diploma, Post Graduate Diploma, Diploma and Certificate Programmes (Revised upto February 2022) available in the Dibrugarh University Website].

Note: Certificate from competent authority must be submitted. Attach additional sheet if necessary

Important Note- The University shall not verify the eligibility of a candidate at the time of receiving their Application Forms and Issuing Admit Card to them. The candidates not fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria shall not be debarred from appearing the Entrance Test.

However, their candidature shall not be considered at the time of admission to the MSW Programme. Hence, the intending candidates are requested to ensure themselves regarding fulfillment of the minimum eligibility for admission into the MSW Programme.

Selection Procedure:

Selection of candidates for admission will be made through a 75 minutes Written Test (60 marks) followed by Group Discussion (20 Marks) and Personal Interview (20 Marks). Only qualified candidates securing minimum 45% marks in Written Test will be called for Group

Discussion and Personal Interview. The Written Test will assess a candidate's knowledge of and sensitivity to contemporary social issues, general knowledge, and reasoning as well as analytical abilities of English.

Note:

- i) The question paper of the written test will be of objective type.
- ii) There will be no negative marks for wrong answers.
- iii) The question paper will be set in English language only.

To qualify for admission, the candidate is required to secure a minimum of 45% marks separately in personal interview; group discussion and the Written Test. Admission will be done strictly on merit basis (Total marks secured in the Written Test, GD and PI).

Admission Procedure:

- a) The admission of the selected candidates shall be done as per the information of the subsequent notifications. The requisite Admission Fees, Course Fees shall have to be paid within the stipulated date(s).
- b) Statutory Reservation Policy shall be followed in preparation of the List of Provisionally Selected Candidates.
- c) The University shall guide the provisionally selected candidates for admission with detailed instruction in due course of time.
- d) The selection of the candidates for admission shall be purely provisional and confirmation is subject to verification of original documents by the concerned offices.
- e) At the time of Admission, the students have to produce and submit the (1) Pass Certificate and Marks Sheets from HSLC onwards (2) Character Certificate from the institute last attended (3) Medical Certificate from a registered medical practitioner vouching the candidate's fitness (4) No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the employer (if employed) for attending the Program.
- f) Keep yourself updated with notification uploaded in the University website from time to time.
