NOTICE FOR WALK-IN INTERVIEW

Applications are invited for the following post mentioned below, under the small grant project entitled “**SOCIO-CULTURAL DETERMINANTS, COMMUNITY AWARENESS, TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION OF PATIENTS OF SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER (SUD) IN ASSAM AND ARUNACHAL PRADESH**” implemented by Department of Sociology, Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh, Assam under ICMR- New Delhi.

1. Name of the Post: Project Research Scientist-II (Non-Medical): **01** (one post)

Essential qualification and experience: The post has essential Qualification of First Class M.A in Sociology/Social Work or a second class degree in M.A in Sociology/Social Work with PhD with requisite research experience and a minimum of 2 years’ field experience in community development. The qualification must also include a minimum of 1 year experience of project management with knowledge of quantitative and qualitative research. Candidates with research experience on substance abuse would be given preference.

Place of Work: Supervisory role in 8 study Districts: 6 Districts of Assam (Dibrugarh, Tinsukia, Cachar, Kamrup (Metro), Nagaon, Karimganj) and 2 Districts of Arunachal Pradesh (Namsai, Changlang)

Monthly Consolidated Emoluments: Rs. 67,000/- per month + 9% HRA = Rs. 73,030 per month.

Upper age –limit: 35 years

2. Name of the Post: Project Research Scientist-I (Non-Medical): **02** (two posts)

Essential qualification and experience: The post has essential Qualification of First Class M.A in Sociology/Social Work or a second class degree in M.A in Sociology/Social Work with PhD and requisite research experience. The Desirable Qualification is a minimum of 1 years of research experience in community development/substance abuse.

Place of Work: 4 Districts out of 8 study Districts : 6 Districts of Assam (Dibrugarh, Tinsukia, Cachar, Kamrup (Metro), Nagaon, Karimganj) and 2 Districts of Arunachal Pradesh (Namsai, Changlang)

3. Name of the Position: Project Technical Support-III: **04** (four posts)
